



Community Agreement

Cornucopia is a diverse community of adults, because we celebrate and value diversity, even while we explore the commonalities that we share. We know that there is strength in our diversity, and that together we all achieve more than we can alone. Cornucopia does not discriminate against any protected class, and will provide reasonable accommodations to the known disabilities of any member, if needed, to participate in a program.

Our Mission: Cornucopia Inc. is an arts and wellness activities center run by and for people who have mental health issues and their allies. We celebrate creativity and diversity through mutual support. We promote growth and dignity by helping members develop individual strengths and talents for use in building on self-directed recovery goals and community and life skills.

As a community, we believe in three broad principles:

- Take care of yourself
- Take care of each other and
- Take care of the space we share

Here are examples of how we practice those principles.

Take care of yourself:

- Know when you need assistance, and ask for it as clearly as you can
- Don't be afraid to speak up for yourself
- To be at Cornucopia, you must be independent in your basic needs; Cornucopia does not provide personal attendants
- Please write on the following page the current contact information (name and phone number) for the person we should call in case of an emergency
- Also, please note if you have a medical condition, or any other reason that you might need major help or a ride

Take care of each other:

- Provide assistance, if asked, or direct requests to a host, volunteer, or other resources, if you can't help
- Don't be afraid to speak up for others if you see something wrong
- Be careful with other people's art work, projects, and supplies
- Respect other people's right to privacy and confidentiality, including not doing anything to or with another person without their consent
- Any behavior that is disruptive or verbally, physically, or emotionally threatening or abusive to anyone will not be tolerated, and may result in being asked to leave

Take care of the space we share:

- Don't be wasteful with supplies provided, use only what you need
- Take responsibility to clean up after yourself
- Help us maintain our space in good condition
